

**In***spired.* This is a great moment for Christ Episcopal School! Since its founding in 1984, CES has grown rapidly from a parish elementary school into a college preparatory school serving some 630 students in Early Pre-k through 12th Grade. To address the continued expansion of CES's enrollment and programs, the Board of Trustees is launching a capital campaign to address the increased urgency of critical campus needs, which include more classroom space, a fieldhouse, a commercial kitchen, security enhancements, and Center of Inquiry modifications to elevate our schoolwide arts programs.

**In***credible.* Our commitment to the academic, artistic, athletic, and spiritual development of each student has translated into unprecedented growth and outstanding achievements in all facets of school life. In 2017-2018, CES continued to succeed, with:

- **record enrollment** in our Early Pre-kindergarten and 7th and 10th grades.
- **a graduating class whose 23 members collectively were accepted to 63 colleges and universities** in 23 states and 2 foreign countries.
- **three varsity athletic teams that captured state championships** in the school's inaugural year of LHSAA competition.
- **six junior varsity teams that claimed NIAL titles.**
- **numerous students who excelled in the arts**, with honors bestowed at multiple local, regional, and national competitions in disciplines including visual arts, music, theater, and speech and debate.



**In***cluded.* The Board of Trustees and administration have been mindful of the school's mission while creating a vision for the future. To meet the ever-expanding needs of this vibrant and dynamic community, we are hopeful you will proclaim "I'm In" to our capital campaign, which will fund these urgently needed facility additions and improvements, including:

- **a new building of eight classrooms**, including three larger-scale STEM classrooms. This building will also serve as the new campus welcome center, with administrative and security offices.
- **security and safety upgrades to include improved campus security**, enhanced communication capability, and updated incident management protocols.
- **a fieldhouse, which will have a capacity of 1,100 people**, allowing the school to host tournaments and playoff games, and accommodate the entire school population when gathering indoors for chapel services, assemblies, and special events. It will also eliminate significant overcrowding in the current gym when P.E. classes must be held indoors.
- **rededicating the Center of Inquiry as the Center for Fine Arts**, where classes in our studio and performing arts programs will be housed. Enhancements to the theater, classrooms, and common areas will benefit students, teachers, and community members who enjoy our productions and exhibitions.
- **a full-service commercial kitchen**, which will address the need for a schoolwide lunch program and include flexible space that can be used as a classroom, conference room, or small dining room.

**In**vested. Since commencing the “We’re All In!” capital campaign in 2012, Christ Episcopal School has invested more than \$8 million in new facilities and campus improvements. Because of generous donors, the school added 12 new classrooms; a performing arts theater; and a Louisiana High School Athletic Association regulation lighted track and field, three tennis courts, and a concessions building, enviable facilities that allow CES to offer 16 different sports and 44 teams to our students. We also acquired eight acres across Christwood Boulevard, bringing the total Christwood campus to 45 acres targeted for wise, student-centered development. This investment has already enhanced our school by generating a 10% increase in total enrollment and 26% growth in our high school population each year since 2009.

The “I’m In” campaign is a continuation of these efforts as we look toward the future of Christ Episcopal School and its ability to inspire all of our students to think critically, engage confidently, and embrace challenges.
