- Plan and deliver developmentally appropriate instruction, as well as follow the accredited curriculum in early literacy, math, and social-emotional learning
- Build a strong foundation in reading through explicit instruction in phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension
- Foster curiosity, problem-solving, and independent thinking through guided exploration and student-centered learning opportunities
- Integrate faith-based principles into daily teaching, modeling compassion, gratitude, and respect for all
- Create a structured, nurturing classroom environment that supports the whole child—academically, socially, emotionally, and spiritually
- Serve as a lead teacher by collaborating with colleagues, mentoring team members, and contributing to a positive campus culture
- Use formative and summative assessments (including DIBELS and Fountas & Pinnell) to guide instruction and monitor student growth
- Maintain ongoing documentation of student progress and communicate effectively with families
- Differentiate instruction to meet the diverse needs of learners
- Partner with colleagues, specialists, and administrators to support student success
- Participate actively in faculty meetings, professional development, and school-wide events
